



## **Conflict Minerals**

The Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010 requires U.S. companies to publicly disclose the use of any “conflict minerals” (Tin, Tungsten, Tantalum or Gold that have originate from the Democratic Republic of Congo) in their products. Such minerals may be directly or indirectly financing armed groups engaged in civil war in the Eastern Congo, resulting in serious social and environmental abuses.

Although not bound by U.S. law, B&P Fabrications supports this legislation and does not knowingly use materials that contain conflict minerals, nor do we work with suppliers who have publically disclosed that they use conflict minerals. Based on reasonable inquires with our suppliers, to our knowledge, our products have not contained conflict minerals since November 2015. It is the expectation of B&P Fabrications that all our suppliers provide materials from socially and environmentally responsible sources.
